Will set fruit without the introduction of another variety.

Disease & Frost resistant. • Cox's Self Fertile - Tasty dessert apple crops from mid Sept. • Red Devil - Crisp, juicy & fruity. Disease resistant. Crops from late Sept. 	<p style="text-align: center;">Companion Varieties</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Katy - Easy to grow & disease resistant. Bright red, juicy fruit from early Sept. • Elstar - Crop in early Oct. Excellent flavour and juicy. • James Grieve - Juicy & tangy. Yellow fruit in early Sept. 	<p style="text-align: center;">Family Varieties</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • James Grieve & Elstar - crops throughout sept and oct, red & yellow fruit • James Grieve & Cox's Self Fertile - crops throughout sept, red & yellow fruit
