Features	Compact, bushy shrub with Silver/grey foliage and dark blue – purple flowers all summer
Benefits	Very fragrant flowers for a long period, which also attract bees and butterflies. A vigorous garden shrub, can also be used as a low hedge. Excels in drought conditions.
Story	This specific variety is a cross between the French and English types of lavender. The scent derives from the English type, and the oil produced can be used as an antiseptic and is soothing.
