Selling	August to September
Features	Bell shaped, deep rose flowers from July to September.
Benefits	Attractive due to its unusual flowers, which point upwards and not down. A long flowering season and scented.
Story	Bred by Wim Snoeijer , who has been breeding Clematis for many years, it is a cross between 'Purpureostriata' and 'Alionushka' and was introduced in 2003.
