

# Achillea ‘Rose Madder’



<b>Selling</b>	June
<b>Features</b>	Deep green foliage with clusters of red heads from June
<b>Benefits</b>	Compact perennial, with a long flowering period. The flowers fade to a biscuit colour, and it will grow well in dry borders. One of the best Achilleas available, wonderful in cottage style gardens.
<b>Story</b>	Achillea is named after the Greek mythological character Achilles, as it was ‘thought’ to have healed the wounds of soldiers.
<b>Basic Information</b>	
<b>Plant type</b>	Perennial
<b>Flowers</b>	Red plume like heads from June
<b>Height after 4 years</b>	45cm (18”)
<b>Spread after 4 years</b>	50cm (20”)
<b>Position</b>	Sun or partial shade in well drained soil
<b>Hardiness</b>	Hardy to -20°C
