

# Cordyline ‘Torbay Red’



<b>Selling</b>	March onwards
<b>Features</b>	Deep burgundy, sword-like leaves, with small scented white flowers in Summer.
<b>Benefits</b>	An architectural feature plant. Excellent in pots. Can be used as a feature in the middle of a border.
<b>Story</b>	Cordyline australis is commonly known as the Cabbage Tree Palm. This is a deep burgundy form introduced to the UK by the Torbay Palm Farm.

<b>Flowers</b>	Insignificant small scented white flowers
<b>Height after 4 years</b>	1.8m (6')
<b>Spread after 4 years</b>	1.2m (4')
<b>Position</b>	Sheltered sunny spot in well-drained soil
<b>Hardiness</b>	Hardy to -5°C
