Features

Broad, toothed mid green foliage with cup shaped dark plum flowers in early Summer.

Benefits

An early flowering, flamboyant feature plant, offering lasting interest. The flowers change from plum wine coloured to purplish brown as they open and leave impressive seed heads.

Developed by Kingsdon Somerton Nursery, Somerset, where it was initially found as a seedling on their compost heap.
