**Features**

From July, intense golden yellow flowers with striking burgundy centres which turn fiery rustic orange.

**Benefits**

A real eye catcher, with huge flowers over a long period. Excellent in a mixed herbaceous border. The colours change in tune with the seasons.

**Story**

In 1989 a British Gardener bought seeds from a local market in India. Sown in Bridgnorth, two grew and were trialled by a local nursery. It was introduced by Webbs and named in honour of the Queen’s Golden Jubilee.
