White flowers in late Spring. Mini conical shaped peppers turn from deep green to deep orange from July onwards.

A very compact plant, ideal for patio pots. The peppers are very sweet and ideal for salads and stir fries.

The name Pepper, although it is slightly misleading, was given to these fruits by Christopher Columbus, who introduced them to Europe. Peppercorns were highly valued at this time.
